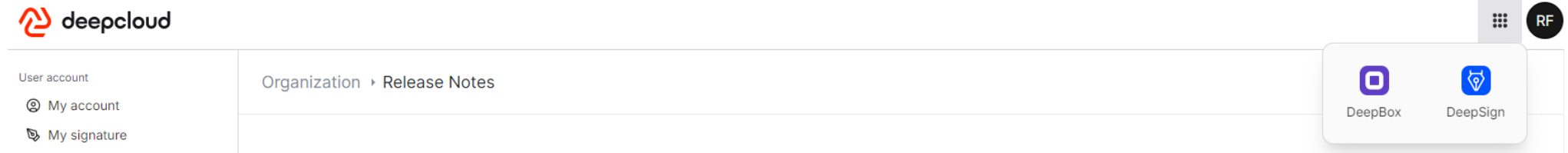

A new Header with an App Switcher was developed for DeepAdmin. This makes it easier to navigate between the various applications.





i Batch Signing

As part of Batch Signing, multiple documents can be signed at the same time. This is possible in the "To sign" tab. Only documents with the same security level and jurisdiction can be signed at the same time (e.g. qualified and QES).

If the visual signature should be placed on the documents, this must be done before the Batch Signing process is started.
