Redesigned and enhanced search

- Significantly improved scoring and ranking of search results.
- Folders are now included in search results.
- Search now takes substantially more metadata into account.
- Minor usability and design improvements have been made to the search function and search results view.

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Enhanced authentication requirements for Shares

It is now possible to require two-factor authentication (2FA) or single sign-on (SSO) before users can access a shared box.

- During onboarding to a shared box, users are directed to enable 2FA.
- Users who have not enabled 2FA are denied access when attempting to open a shared box or shared folder.

Enhanced authentication requirements for Shares

New settings are now available in DeepAdmin:

- At **sections level**: owners or admins can define whether two-factor authentication (2FA) and/or single sign-on (SSO) should be required by default when creating new shares. This requirement can also be enabled for existing shares.

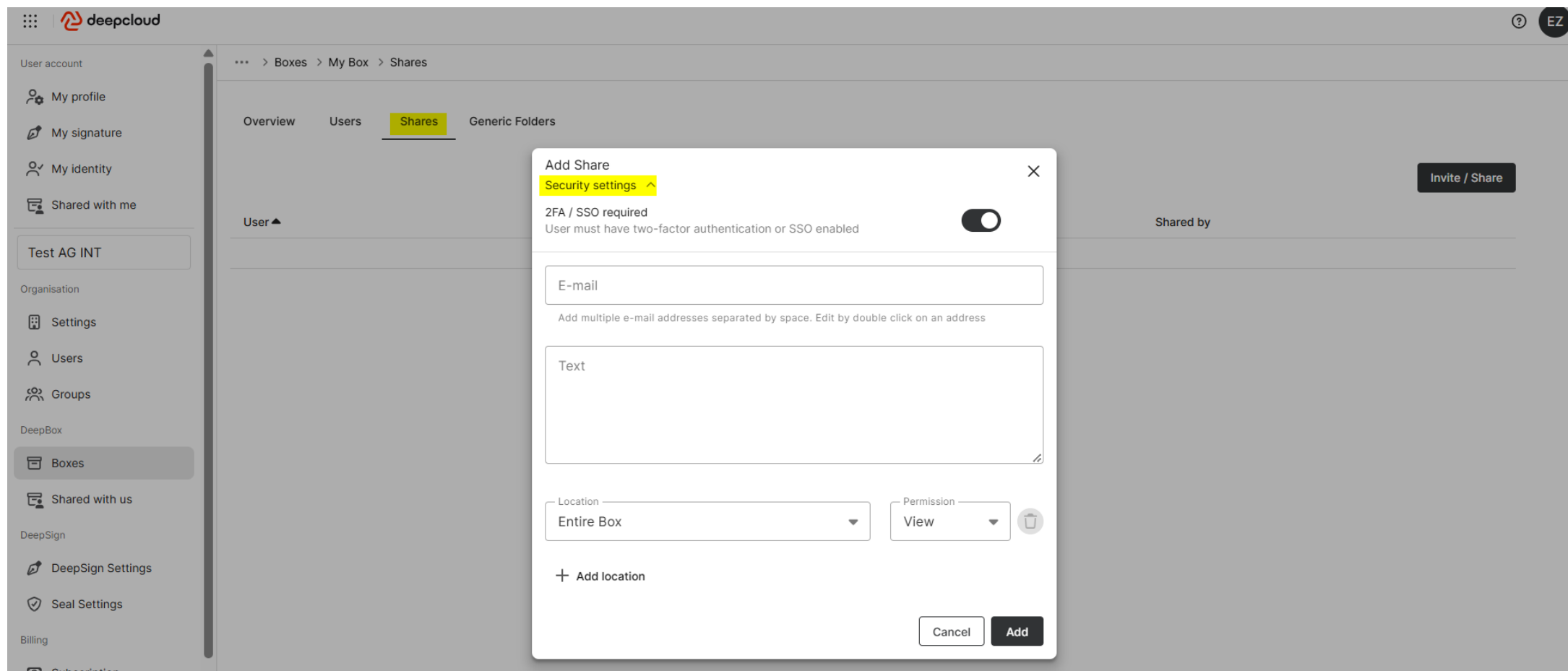
If this option is enabled, sharing a box within this section will by default require recipients to use two-factor authentication (2FA) or Single Sign-On (SSO).

Enhanced authentication requirements for Shares

New settings are now available in DeepAdmin:

- At the **shares level**: owners or admins can define whether authentication requirements individually for each user with access to a shared box. They can specify whether two-factor authentication (2FA) and/or single sign-on (SSO) is required. This setting overrides the configuration defined at the sections level.

Various bug fixes and improvements, such as

- Made minor improvements to the address feature, available in the inbox of Advanced Boxes.
- Optimised the download process for the DeepBox drive application.
- Fixed an issue that prevented certain PDF documents with attached XML files from being displayed in the preview.
- The notification regarding unpaid invoices is no longer displayed to members and admins in the DeepBox dashboard.
- Fixed an issue that could cause the organisation name to be displayed twice in the sharing invitation text.
- Fixed an issue where, in certain cases, the initiator was not correctly removed from a signature process started through DeepBox.

- Improved redirection in specific onboarding scenarios.
- Fixed an issue where new users with a verified email domain were incorrectly redirected to sign in instead of onboarding in certain cases.
- Optimised the two-factor authentication (2FA) setup screen.

Various bug fixes and improvements, such as

- Improved signature placement and easier repositioning, including in documents with pages of different sizes.
- Various minor improvements and optimisations to the DeepSign envelope feature introduced in early september.
- Added validation of the maximum signature resolution to ensure reliable and smooth performance, even when using large signatures.

Various bug fixes and improvements, such as

- Added support for validating document timestamps.
- The PAdES signature level is now displayed.
- Added information on the evidential value of the respective signature type.
- Revised and improved the wording of warning messages.
- Made various improvements to the PDF report.
